Box Indoor Lacrosse League

INDOOR LACROSSE

VOLT Box lacrosse, also known as indoor lacrosse and sometimes shortened to box lax or simply box, is an indoor version of lacrosse played mostly in North America. The game originated in Canada where it is the most popular version of the game played in contrast to the traditional field lacrosse game. It is played between two teams of 4-5 players and one goalie each and is traditionally played on an ice hockey rink or smaller field area. The playing area is called a box, in contrast to the open playing field of field lacrosse. The object of the game is to use a long handled racket, known as a lacrosse stick, to catch, carry, and pass the ball in an effort to score by ultimately hurling a solid rubber lacrosse ball into an opponent's goal.

Box Lacrosse League Rules of Play

- All players must play in their age division.
- 25 minute halves (running time) / 5 minute half time.
- 4 vs. 4 plus Goalkeepers
- Regulation 6ft. x 6ft. goals for upper age divisions (U15, HS, and College+)
- Small 4ft. x 4ft. goals for lower age divisions (U11 U13)
- Unlimited Substitutions (On the Fly), player must come off before another player can enter the field.
- Traditional face off to start match and after each goal is scored. All other players must stand alone in a separate corner or against the wall at midfield. Players may leave these starting positions upon the whistle, but may not interfere with faceoff players until posession is called out by the official.
- Goalkeepers must make at least one pass within 4 seconds of a save and on the defensive half of the field (i.e. no clearing passes over the midfield line.)
- Players may only shoot while on the offensive half of the field.
- Players may not make contact with a goalkeeper while they are inside their crease area. *Violation of any above rule results in an award/change of possession. Play resumes immediately upon official's whistle.
- All field lacrosse rules apply with the major exception of body checking for boys. NO body checking is allowed, particularly into walls. Both hands must be on their sticks when checking one handed or wrap checks are not allowed. Checks to an opponent's stick, or gloves only! *Violation of the above checking rule results in a change of posession and replacement of the violator for no less than one minute of play. Players are ejected from play (for the day) after a thrid violation. Players with three ejections are banned from play for the session without a refund.
